Takeaway #1:

We are loved by God much more powerfully than we are loved by a spouse.

Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children...(Ephesians 5:1)

Takeaway #2:

Marriage relationships must operate in light of God's love.

And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God...
(Ephesians 5:2)

Takeaway #3:

The greatest goal of marriage is to lead spouses closer to God.
