Jesus in our Homes: Jesus in the “Home” • [Psalm 78:1-7](#) (NLT)

O my people, listen to my instructions. Open your ears to what I am saying, ²for I will speak to you in a parable. I will teach you hidden lessons from our past ³stories we have heard and known, stories our ancestors handed down to us. ⁴We will not hide these truths from our children; we will tell the next generation about the glorious deeds of the LORD, about his power and his mighty wonders. ⁵For he issued his laws to Jacob; he gave his instructions to Israel. He commanded our ancestors to teach them to their children, ⁶so the next generation might know them even the children not yet born and they in turn will teach their own children. ⁷So each generation should set its hope anew on God, not forgetting his glorious miracles and obeying his commands. (Psalm 78:1-7)

Two important truths:

1. Evangelism and discipleship start in the family.
2. The church, in fact, is a family.

Truth #1: The family is the first place where a child learns about God.

- The intertestamental period – from Malachi to Matthew
- The Great Commandment – “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, and with all your strength.” ([Matthew 22:37](#)) (See also [Deuteronomy 6:6-7](#))
- The Great Commission – Jesus’ command to make disciples ([Matthew 28:18-20](#))
- The launching of the multigenerational church ([Acts 2:38-39](#))

Application:

- Sunday school teacher/volunteer
- Tribe leader – youth
- Good News Club – Fruitland Elementary (October 2023)
- Mentor a teen or young adult traveling on the Dominican Republic mission trip.
- Invite the next generation into your life!
